Recycling Basics

At Brooks Township Recycle we provide a free pickup point for common recyclables. These are Paper and Cartons, Carboard, Metal Cans, Plastic (bottles, jars and jugs and Glass (bottles, jars and jugs). All these items **MUST** be dry and empty. Carboard must be flattened before placed in a bin.

Do not bring wet or unemptied recyclables. These items are not recyclable and will make other items they soil in the same bin unrecyclable as well. Do not bag them in a plastic garbage bag and place the garbage bag in the recycling. This makes for more manual labor to open the garage bag and further sorting. We cannot process plastic bags or plastic wrap, food ore liquids, Styrofoam, shredded paper or used household items or furniture.

Recycle Key Points:

- Empty, Clean, and Dry
(Rinse bottles, cans, and containers to remove food and liquid residue.)
- No Bagging
(Do not pace recycling in a plastic or trash bag.)
- Check Local Rules
(Guidelines with photos are posted on a sign and on the bins to help.)
- When in Doubt, Throw it Out!
(If you are unsure if an item is recyclable, it is best to place it in the trash to avoid contamination.)

Please recycle responsibly. No trash or dumping! Dumping or leaving trash will lead to fines, legal action, and possible closure of this site.
